When: Spring 2021 Semester: January 12–May 14, 2021

Who: Third- and fourth-year international undergraduate students interested in or majoring in computer science

- ❑ Study online with UC Berkeley faculty and students

 - TOEFL: 90
 - IELTS of 7.0
 - TEM-4 or TEM-8: 70
 - **Online English Language Proficiency Interview**
- Indicate course(s) of interest in the application
